All residential, commercial, and industrial buildings within the City of Santa Cruz water service area are required to be retrofitted with high efficiency plumbing fixtures when a property is sold. This form is used to certify that all plumbing fixtures at the property meet the high efficiency requirements.

Summary of the City of Santa Cruz Plumbing Fixture Retrofit Ordinance

Santa Cruz Municipal Code Chapter 16.03 Santa Cruz County Code Chapter 7.69 City of Capitola Municipal Code Chapter 13.02

All residential, commercial, and industrial buildings receiving water from the City of Santa Cruz are required to be retrofitted completely, if not already conforming, with high efficiency plumbing fixtures at the time of sale of the property. Under the law, the **seller of the property** is responsible for the following:

1. Replacing any toilets, showerheads, and urinals that don't meet the water consumption standards,
2. Arranging for a verification inspection, and
3. Obtaining a Water Conservation Certificate from the Water Department.

A copy of the Water Conservation Certificate is to be included with documents transferring title to the property.

Water Consumption Plumbing Standards

Plumbing fixtures must be manufactured to meet the flush volume and flow rate standards listed below, or less. Flow restrictors and other modifications to fixtures are not acceptable.

Instructions

Step 1 - Retrofit: Make sure that all fixtures on the property you are selling meet the plumbing standards listed above, and replace any that do not. If you are unsure how much water your toilet flushes, see the information sheet *How Much Water Does Your Toilet Use?*, available at the Water Department or on the City web site: www.cityofsantacruz.com/surfcitysave.

Step 2 - Inspection: Complete this form and contact the Water Conservation Office to arrange for a free inspection. You may choose to hire a licensed plumbing or general building contractor to perform the inspection, if you prefer. If so, the contractor will need to complete Part 3 on the front of this form. Contractors may not inspect their own property. An inspection by city staff is required if a notice of violation has been recorded against a property. Properties built in 1994 or later do not need an inspection.

Step 3 - Certification: The Water Conservation Office will sign the certificate at the time of inspection. If you choose to have the property inspected by a licensed plumbing or building contractor, bring in or mail the completed form to:

When received at the office, the certificate will be signed and returned to you. Please note that the Water Conservation Office cannot accept certificates with missing signatures or incomplete information.

Option to Have Buyer Retrofit

The responsibility for retrofitting may be transferred from the seller to the buyer, if both parties mutually agree to do so. If the buyer of your property prefers to complete the retrofit, call the Water Conservation Office for a **Transfer of Responsibility to Retrofit Form**. You can also download the form at the Water Conservation web site. The seller must file the signed form with the Water Conservation Office, in lieu of this certificate, before the property is sold.

Exemptions

If you have proof that the plumbing drainage system will not function properly with high efficiency fixtures, you may request an exemption. Registered historic structures with authentic plumbing fixtures may also be granted an exemption. The Water Conservation Office will need sufficient evidence and an inspection to substantiate an exemption of your property. Contact the Water Conservation Office for more information regarding exemptions.

Failure to Retrofit

You will be liable to the buyer for \$250 for each fixture that does not comply, or for the actual cost to the buyer to comply, whichever is greater, if you fail to complete the retrofit.
